

Swiss prices are transparent and competitive, with the lowest VAT rate in Europe at 7.7% – taxes and services included.


Attractiveness

Located either directly on the lake side, in the city centre, in a university campus or even within walking distance of 1,000 hotel rooms, each and every convention centre has its particular setting and style.

SWISSTECH CONVENTION CENTER

The SwissTech Convention Center (STCC) is one of the most modern and best equipped conference centres in the world.

By making it possible to organise the most ambitious meetings, the STCC gives the Lausanne Federal Institute of Technology (EPFL) the means to uphold its strong position within Europe's scientific community.

The STCC has a seating capacity for a total of 3,000 people and comprises a large 2,200-seat auditorium, an 800-seat balcony and 17 breakout rooms; all of them fully modular.

The centre showcases a combination of futuristic technology and modularity. The architecture of the building allows three auditoriums to become one using a fully automated walls system; the number of seats in each auditorium can also be changed in just a few minutes as the seats can be retracted at the touch of a button, giving way to a flat surface. The SwissTech Convention Center is the venue of choice for many illustrious scientific congresses.

MONTREUX MUSIC 8 CONVENTION CENTRE - 2M2C

The 2m2c Montreux Music & Convention Centre is a venue dedicated to cultural and business events, offering multi-purpose facilities in the authentic and spectacular setting of Montreux on the shores of Lake Geneva. It combines quality and know-how in the organisation of events since over 45 years. Its 18,000 square metres of flexible, multifunctional spaces facilitate the organisation of professional and cultural events for up to 1,800 conference delegates and 3,500 concert-goers.

Its proximity to rail networks, hotels, the Casino and many shops and restaurants makes it a perfect location for international events, the most famous of which are undoubtedly the Montreux Jazz Festival, the XIIIe "Sommet de la Francophonie" or the 2015 European Fencing Championships.

BEAULIEU LAUSANNE CONVENTION CENTER

THE OLYMPIC MUSEUM

Lausanne – the Olympic Capital – is proud of its museum, founded by the IOC itself. Completely updated with the latest museum and event technologies, it is now a totally unique venue worldwide. Alongside the extraordinary collection of medals, torches and other Olympic objects, the 200-seat auditorium is equipped with the latest audiovisual technologies. Additional spaces and a restaurant can be used to host receptions for 1,000 people and gala dinners for up to 500 guests. Not forgetting the exceptional natural setting with views of Lake Geneva and the Alps, as well as access to the vast sculpture garden. To make the most of the sporting theme, The Olympic Museum offers themed events and productions.

THE OLYMPIC MUSEUM THE OLYMPIC PARK



AQUATIS, SWISS AQUARIUM & VIVARIUM

At the same time a recreational area, a pole of environmental education and a platform for exchanges, Aquatis invites visitors to dive head first into a trip around the five continents to discover their main freshwater ecosystems in Lausanne.

CITY TOURS

To enjoy the best sightseeing experiences, a variety of guided city tours are available, organised either by the partners of the Tourism Offices of Lausanne or Montreux or by yourself.



With the area's engaging cultural and historic heritage, attendees are able to explore a variety of activities, attractions and breathtaking local sights and flavours. Be it Glacier 3000 or the Lavaux vineyards, a UNESCO World Heritage site, a host of unique team-building experiences are just a stone's throw away.

BOAT CRUISE ON LAKE GENEVA - CGN

Founded in 1873, the Compagnie Générale de Navigation (CGN) has the largest fleet of "Belle Epoque" boats in Europe, with eight of its twenty boats equipped with paddle wheels. From seminars or exhibitions to gala meals cooked by prestigious chefs and caterers, CGN boats adapt to each event. Capacity up to 1,400 people.

LAVAUX VINEYARDS & WINE TASTING

Discover the most spectacularly steep terraced vineyards – a UNESCO World Heritage site – that overlook Lake Geneva, not forgetting to taste the fine local wines on offer in an authentic cellar.

CHILLON CASTLE

This 12th-century architectural jewel located on a rock on the shore of Lake Geneva near Montreux is easily reached aboard a Belle Epoque paddle steamer, and makes for a truly unforgettable visit.

CHAPLIN'S WORLD

Set in Charlie Chaplin's former house in Corsier-sur-Vevey, the Manoir de Ban, this museum provides an informative and immersive insight into the work and life of one of the most iconic names in film. After visiting the manor and its gardens, visitors embark on a journey through the sets of his greatest films.

WATCH VALLEY

This excursion will take you through the famous Watch Valley, along the Swiss Jura Arc, which is the primary location of the Swiss watchmaking industry. Here, you will discover the know-how and meticulous precision of our watchmakers, with the possibility to visit a variety of museums, showcasing everything from a clock's assembly to its detailed adornments.

SWISS CHOCOLATE AND CHEESE EXPERIENCE


